- C. Almost all, but not all, of the plaintiffs in the Removal Action and the petitioners in the EIS Proceeding are the same.
- D. The New York State Department of Transportation, its Commissioner, Marie Therese Dominguez (in her official capacity) and Chief Engineer, Stephanie Winkelhake, P.E. (in her official capacity) are defendants/respondents in the Removal Action and the Article 78 Proceedings.
- E. The Article 78 Proceedings and the Removal Action have been assigned to the Hon. Emilio Colaiacovo.
- F. Counsel for all parties in the Removal Action and the Article 78 Proceedings have conferred for the purposes of charting a procedure for the filing of further papers to promote judicial economy and to eliminate confusion or prejudice that might result in the absence of such a procedure.

 Proceedings shall be filed on or before September 6, 2024; should DOT move in whole or in part in response to one or more of the Article 78 Proceedings,

 Petitioners' opposition to the motion(s) shall be filed on or before September 20, 2024, and DOT's reply on the motion(s), if any, shall be filed on or before September 27, 2024;
- d. The return date for the Article 78 Proceedings shall be October 11, at 10:30 am
 2024, or such other date and at such time as the Court directs. The parties will appear for argument in person in Part 4, located at 92 Franklin Street, third floor, Buffalo, NY;
- 2. Defendants shall answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint in the Removal Action by August 23, 2024; should Defendants move in response to the Complaint, Plaintiffs' opposition to the motion(s) shall be filed on or before September 20, 2024, and Defendants' replies, if any, shall be filed on or before September 27, 2024. The at 10:30 am return date for any such motion shall be October 11, 2024, or such other date and at such time as the Court directs. The parties will appear for argument in person in Part 4, located at 92 Franklin Street, third floor, Buffalo, NY; and
- 3. The foregoing is not intended as a waiver of the right of any party to file any other paper or motion, or the right of any other party to object to same, and the parties shall confer about scheduling in such event.
